DOCTRINAL STATEMENT







This journal article is a peer-reviewed item which was published in *Conspectus* (Volume 09: March 2010). *Conspectus* is a journal of the South African Theological Seminary (SATS). In the abstract of this publication Prof Jabini states:

"Philip, a Hellenistic Jew, preached the gospel to the Samaritans who were despised by the Jews. The Samaritans were oppressed by evil spirits. They suffered from various kinds of diseases and were in the bondage of Simon the magus. The Samaritans lived in a pluralistic religious community. The confrontation of this community with the gospel produced visible results: people were healed and delivered. Believers were baptized and there was great joy in the city. Transformation took place because Philip preached Christ. This seems to have been the apostolic pattern. The same Christ-centred preaching and communication of the gospel should be followed by ministers of the gospel in today's pluralistic religious world."



ACHIEVEMENTS: PROMOTION OF PROF. JABINI


